

Anne Hamersley Primary School Uniform Policy - 2020

RATIONALE

At Anne Hamersley Primary School, we value and promote a high standard of dress by developing a consistent set of expectations. Students will wear the correct uniform from Kindergarten to Year 6.

AIM

By setting consistent standards and expectations across the school, we can ensure the continuity of appropriate dress code by all students. This creates a sense of identity and pride among the students and wider school community, and helps students learn the importance of appropriate presentation. The aim of this policy is to ensure that students in our school wear the correct Anne Hamersley Primary School Uniform with a sense of pride. This policy will be implemented throughout the year.

POLICY

As we are an Independent Public School we are granted the ability to enforce additional dress code standards to the Department of Education Policy once endorsed by the school board.

For those students not wearing school uniform, or attending school with anything in the '**Dress Code Exclusions list**', teachers must complete the following in order:

1. Verbal reminder to student
2. Reminder to parent (verbal, phone call, email or via. Class Communication). Please ensure you record this in Integris.
3. Standardised Uniform letter home- found in the Admin photocopy room.

Please note- only move to the next step if nothing changes. Be fair and consider family circumstances.

If the student is still attending school with the incorrect uniform after the three steps have been conducted, please contact Admin.

Our School Board have endorsed the following list of requirements for the Anne Hamersley Primary School dress code:

DAILY DRESS CODE

- Uniform dress (with an embroidered logo)
- Uniform Polo Shirt
- Navy Skorts
- Navy Shorts
- Navy tracksuit pants
- Uniform navy jacket- with or without logo/or navy jumper
- Black school shoes (These don't necessarily have to be leather school shoes)
- White socks
- Hair longer than shoulder length to be tied up

SPORTS UNIFORM

- Polo top or house shirt with navy skorts or sport shorts.
- Sports shoes may be worn on the days that sports uniforms are worn for sport.
- A sun safe hat in the school colours is compulsory. Brim to be approximately 7cm.

***DRESS CODE EXCLUSIONS**

- Foot Wear- thongs, slip-ons, ugg boots, rubber boots, football boots in class, high heels or platform shoes, coloured joggers
- Jewellery (**only** watches, ear studs and sleepers are acceptable)
- Make-up, including nail polish
- Clothing- clothes with offensive slogans or pictures (including logos bigger than a bankcard), t-shirts and long pants not in school colours, jeans, camouflage clothing, black clothing, checked shirts, long coloured striped/patterned socks, board shorts, denim shorts and revealing shorts (too tight/ too short)
- Hair- Hair dye (natural hair colour only), coloured extensions
- Headwear- caps, large hair accessories (bows, tiaras, holiday braids)

MODIFICATION TO DRESS CODE

Students who, for religious or health reasons, may need to modify the school dress code, are required to make an appointment with the Principal to discuss alternatives. Staff will be informed of these students.

All school staff will implement a consistent approach to the Uniform Policy at Anne Hamersley Primary School.
