Dear Parents / Care Givers,

As planned, the Perth and Peel post-lockdown restrictions are set to be significantly eased further from 12.01am Saturday, May 1.

The easing of restrictions will see Perth and Peel move closer to the return of pre-lockdown life, but a small number of transitional measures will remain in place until Saturday, May 8. I am writing to advise that schools remain open, and masks are required for all staff and secondary school students. Teachers can remove masks to teach.

Venue capacity limits have also been eased and parents/carers are able to attend school activities such as assemblies and events. Masks are mandatory for parents/carers to wear indoors and outdoors where physical distancing is not possible.

This week's assembly will go ahead with masks mandatory for staff and parents in attendance. Masks will also be required for parents who enter classrooms, with parents required to sign in.
