Dear Parents / Caregivers,

Again, I extend my thoughts to all of you as we start to understand the impact of the Woorlooloo fire and what it means for many of our families.

As we work through this as a community, I want to assure you that we are here to do whatever we can to help support you and your children.

As the fire is still uncontrolled and uncontained, we do not have much information at this time about what school will look like for your child next week and it may be some days before we do.

What I can tell you, is that once the fire is controlled and it is deemed safe to enter the area, our school will need to be inspected and authorised to reopen to ensure it is safe for staff and students to return. At this stage, we do not have a timeframe for this.

When we have more information, arrangements will be put in place for your child's ongoing education and return to school.

Every decision we make will be with the best interests and the safety of your children in mind and we are here to work with you through this.
