Dear Parents / Carers,

Following my communication informing you that our school has been assessed and cleared to open Monday 8 February, I am writing to inform of some COVID-safe measures that will be implemented to ensure we are following the WA Health and WA Government's latest advice. These measures will continue until 12:01am, 14 February, details at [WA.gov.au](http://WA.gov.au).

For the next week, teachers and staff in our school will need to wear masks, however our students do not. You might want to let your child know that they will see staff wearing masks, and that teachers may take their mask off when teaching. Our staff will explain to our students the importance of wearing a mask as together we work through this transition. To assist preparing the students for this, photos of the staff wearing their masks have been displayed on our Facebook page.

Parents are allowed on school sites; provided they:

- Wear a mask at all times.
- Practice 1.5 metres between adults physical distancing, where practicable; and
- Follow good hand and respiratory hygiene practices.

Parents are allowed to enter classrooms; provided they:

- Sign-In using the manual register provided outside the classroom.
- Keep their time in the classroom to a minimal.
- Wear a mask at all times.
- Practice 1.5 metres between adults physical distancing, where practicable; and
- Follow good hand and respiratory hygiene practices.

- Before and After School Care, Camp Australia will also be resuming their normal hours of operation.
- The canteen will also be open for business this Tuesday 9 February.
- It must be clarified that this will be the commencement of Week 2. Therefore, parents of Kindergarten students, should refer to their timetable for Kindergarten days.
- School playgrounds will be open for students to access.
- No assembly will occur this week.
