ENROLMENTS

Thank you to all of the prospective parents for your emails, phone calls and visits to our temporary office regarding enrolment at Anne Hamersley Primary School. We have had a lot of interest, and queries regarding our school, and look forward to meeting new families expecting to move into the area soon!

As many of you are aware, the Enrolment process is in two parts. Firstly, an Application for Enrolment will need to be completed. Supporting documentation must be provided when this is submitted including your child's birth certificate or passport, immunisation records and proof of your address (eg. telephone account, rates bill). If applicable, further information of any court order provisions and evidence of citizenship and residency status will be required.

Once we have received this information, and established that you live within our school boundary you will receive a Student Enrolment Form, which is confirmation of your acceptance into Anne Hamersley Primary School. On returning, could you please provide copies of your child's most recent school report, and NAPLAN results.
