

REMINDER TO PARENTS OF CURRENT KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS

It is a requirement of the Department of Education that all children currently enrolled in Kindergarten reapply and enrol for entry into Pre Primary in 2018. Admission into Pre-Primary will not be possible until the enrolment process has been completed. Please visit the School Office along with the following documents:

- Birth Certificate
- Current ACIR Immunisation Statement
- Proof of address less than 3 months old (Rates Notice, Tenancy Agreement, Utility Bill)
- Application for Enrolment Form (available from our website at www.annehamersleyps.wa.edu.au or the School Office)

Your application will then be assessed and if all criterion are met, you will be required to complete an Enrolment Form. If for any reason you have decided against enrolling your child, please inform our Enrolment Officer on 9297-7000 as soon as possible. Office hours are Monday to Friday between 8.30am and 3.30pm. If you are currently residing outside our catchment area as described to you by our Enrolment Officer, it will not be possible for your child to continue at Anne Hamersley Primary School in 2018.

EARLY CLOSE PICK UP REMINDER

Parents/carers are requested to ensure that children are collected on time at 2:30 pm on early close Wednesday's. Teaching staff attend Professional Development Sessions during this time, therefore supervision cannot be ensured. In the event that children are not collected on time, they will be directed to Camp Australia where you will need to deal with them directly with regard to fees.

TECHNOLOGY UPGRADE

We are happy to announce a significant upgrade to our technology resources. With thanks to our very active P&C an additional twenty six computers and fifteen iPads have been purchased to add to our existing technology bank. This substantial upgrade will provide the opportunity to our students to hone their technology skills in readiness for important milestones such as conducting NAPLAN Online Testing on the horizon for 2018. 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K KAPTURE SCHOOL PHOTO DAY IS COMING! PHOTOGRAPHY

Our school photo day is coming! Approximately two weeks prior to the photo day every student will receive a Kapture Photography order envelope to bring home. The recommended method of ordering your photos is online through Kapture's website as your payment is secure and can be easily verified at any time. If you pay online, there is no need to return the order envelope to school at any time. Alternatively you can pay by cash and return the provided envelope to Kapture on the photography day. **Please note the photographers cannot open sealed envelopes and cannot provide change.** You also have the option to order a sibling photo package online, however please note sibling orders will close at least one day before photo day. We suggest you place your online sibling order as soon as you receive your order envelope with your order instructions.

**Log on to www.kapture.com.au for your sibling photo closing date.
Late requests cannot be granted.**

Late payment envelopes cannot be accepted by the school office or by Kapture. You can place an order online for class or individual photographs at any time for the remainder of the current school year however a \$10 fee will apply if you order more than 5 days after photography. If your child is in a sports or special group photo, you can use the same school code on your order envelope to view and order these photos on Kapture's website, around the time that school photos are ready to be delivered. Please note; Class group, individual and sibling portraits are not available to view online. Kapture offer a money back guarantee for any parent who is not fully satisfied with their photo package. *All students will be photographed individually on photo day for school administration records AS WELL as included in their class group photo available for purchase to all families. Should there be any reason why your child should **NOT** be included in the photo shoot –please contact the school office.*

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GUESS IF YOU CAN - Grades K-5

What to do

1. Let your child think of a number between a stated range of numbers while you try to guess the number by asking questions. Here is a sample conversation.
Child: I am thinking of a number between 1 and 100.
Parent: Is it more than 50?
Child: No.
Parent: Is it an even number?
Child: No.
Parent: Is it more than 20 but less than 40?
Child: Yes.
Parent: Can you reach it by starting at zero and counting by 3's?
Child: Yes.
(At this stage, your child could be thinking of 21, 27, 33, or 39.)
2. Figure out the answers to your own questions.
3. After you have guessed your child's number, let your child guess a number from you by asking similar questions.
