REMINDER TO PARENTS OF CURRENT KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS

It is a requirement of the Department of Education that all children currently enrolled in Kindergarten reapply and enrol for entry into Pre Primary in 2020. Admission into Pre-Primary will not be possible until the enrolment process has been completed. Please visit the School Office along with the following documents:

- Birth Certificate · Current ACIR Immunisation Statement · Proof of address less than 3 months old (Rates Notice, Tenancy Agreement, Utility Bill) · Application for Enrolment Form (available from our website at www.annehamersleysps.wa.edu.au or the School Office)

Your application will then be assessed, and if all criterion are met, you will be required to complete an Enrolment Form. If for any reason you have decided against enrolling your child, please inform our Enrolment Officer on 9297-7000 as soon as possible. Office hours are Monday to Friday between 8.30am and 3.30pm. If you are currently residing outside our catchment area, as described to you by our Enrolment Officer, it will not be possible for your child to continue at Anne Hamersley Primary School in 2020.

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Term 3 SWIMMING CLASSES HAVE COMMENCED

Swimming classes commenced on Monday 2 September 2019, Week 7 and will conclude on Friday 14 September 2019, Week 8. Thanks to parents and guardians that have made payment for their children to attend the swimming classes. The facilities at the pool are well maintained with regular safety checks of water purity for swimming. The change rooms will cater for the needs of our children and will house our numbers with comfort. Mr Hall will remain at the pool for the duration of the lessons to ensure transitions between the school and the venue run smoothly. This arrangement will also guarantee that the boys have a male teacher in attendance at all times. Mrs Bell has to be thanked for all the organisation thus far which includes all the timetabling and bus services for the swimming lessons. At the end of our ten sessions children should be awarded a Pass or a Participation Certificate. The table to below is a shortened guide to levels in these classes.

| Stage | Title | Guidelines for students entering the stage |
|-------|---|--|
| 1 | Beginner | None required |
| 2 | Water/surf discovery | Glide forward and glide backward and recover to a stand. |
| 3 | Preliminary | Swim 5m freestyle. Glide backward, kick and recover to a stand. |
| 4 | Water/surf intro awareness | Swim 10m freestyle, face in water. Swim 5m breaststroke kick. |
| 5 | Water/surf sense | Swim 15m freestyle, 10m backstroke and 10m survival backstroke. |
| 6 | Junior | Swim 25m freestyle plus 15m breaststroke or 15m survival backstroke. |
| 7 | Intermediate | Swim 50m freestyle, or freestyle and one other stroke, continuously. |
| 8 | Water/surf wise | Capacity to swim effectively using a range of strokes over 150m. |
| 9 | Senior | Capacity to swim effectively using a range of strokes over 200m. |
| 10 | Junior swim and survive/ surf stage 10 | Effective swimming skills with a sound knowledge and understanding of water safety. |
| 11 | Swim and survive/ surf stage 11 | Effective swimming skills with a developing knowledge and understanding of personal safety and survival skills. |
| 12 | Senior swim and survive /surf stage 12 | Effective swimming skills including the ability to complete a clothed swim and a sound understanding of personal safety and survival skills. |

NAPLAN 2020 RESULTS

Individual Student Reports (ISR) are expected to be delivered to schools across Australia later in Term 3. All Yr 3 and Yr 5 students that sat the Online NAPLAN Test will receive an ISR. Reports will be handed to students to deliver to parents as soon as the reports have been checked and delivered to the school.

Guess If You Can

Grades K-5

What to do

1. Let your child think of a number between a stated range of numbers while you try to guess the number by asking questions. Here is a sample conversation.

Child: I am thinking of a number between 1 and 100.

Parent: Is it more than 50?

Child: No.

Parent: Is it an even number?

Child: No.

Parent: Is it more than 20 but less than 40?

Child: Yes.

Parent: Can you reach it by starting at zero and counting by 3's?

Child: Yes.

(At this stage, your child could be thinking of 21, 27, 33, or 39.)



2. Figure out the answers to your own questions.
3. After you have guessed your child's number, let your child guess a number from you by asking similar questions.

WELCOME TO SUSTAINABILITY CORNER



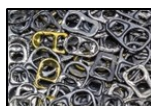

Dealing with Disappointment

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Dealing with Disappointment

By Professor Matt Sanders

Despite what certain sport shoe commercials might have you believe, life isn't always about winning.

It is equally important for the development of healthy self-esteem that children learn how to deal with disappointment.

As a reaction to not getting what they want, such as being chosen for a team, children may sometimes put themselves down, saying things like: "I'm dumb", "you hate me" or "I'm just stupid". If this happens, try to avoid being too sympathetic. Instead encourage your child to try again after the set-back and to enjoy the activity or game even if they aren't the winner.

Rather than simply reassuring your child that everything will be okay, you can help your child develop their own sense of worth by letting them know that you understand their feelings of disappointment and that you are there to help them work out a reasonable way of dealing with that disappointment.

Remember too, when you're helping your child with an activity or with homework concentrate on effort not results. Praising your child for trying and making an improvement will motivate them to continue trying at a difficult task.

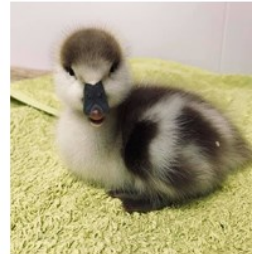
