MATHS MANIA

Which is a better estimate for the weight of a basket of apples?

1 gram

1 kilogram

More or Less

Grades K-2

What you'll need One coin, number cards (from book cover), scratch paper, pen, and pencil

What to do

Two players will play a card game where each will draw a card. The players will compare cards to see who wins that round. Before you begin, flip the coin and call

"heads" or "tails" to see if the winner of each round will be the person with a greater value card (heads) or a smaller value card (tails).

- 1. To begin the game, divide the cards evenly between the two players.
- 2. Place the cards face down. Each player turns over one card at a time and compares: Is mine more or less? How many more? How many less? The player with the greater or smaller value card (depending on whether heads or tails was tossed) takes both cards.
- 3. The winner of the game is the player with more cards when all the cards are gone from the stack.
- 4. Now try the same activity with each player pulling two cards and adding them. Which sum is more? How much more? How much less?

Parent Pointer

Playing with numeral cards helps children learn to compare quantities of numbers. Children can also learn addition and subtraction.

Our school photo day is coming! Approximately two weeks prior to the photo day every student will receive a Kapture Photography personalised flyer to bring home. The only method of ordering your photos is online through Kapture's website as your payment is secure and can be easily verified at any time

SIBLING ORDERS CAN ONLY BE PLACED ONLINE: Late requests cannot be granted.

You have the option to order a sibling photo package online, however please note <u>sibling orders</u> <u>will close in most instances @midday sharp at least one business day before the first photo date.</u> We suggest you place your sibling order as soon as you receive your flyer with your order instructions as places are limited.

Log on to kapture.com.au for your sibling photo order cut-off date and time.

You can place an order online for class or individual photographs at any time for the remainder of the current school year. However, a \$15 fee will apply if you order more than 10 days after photography.

If your child is in a special group photo, you can use the same school code on your information flyer to view and order these photos on Kapture's website, around the time that school photos are ready to be delivered. Please note class groups, individual and sibling portraits are not available to view online.

Kapture offer a money back guarantee for any parent who is not fully satisfied with their photo package. Should you have any queries before or after photo day, please direct them to the Kapture office on 9240 1714 or email enquiries@kapture.com.au.

All students will be photographed individually on photo day for school administration records AS WELL as included in their class group photo available for purchase to all families. Should there be any reason why your child should <u>NOT</u> be included in the photo shoot –please contact the school office.
